ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17840 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON OCT 19 1992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VIII, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 84.12 RELATING TO SKATEBOARDS.

WHEREAS, there have been unacceptable noise levels in the Mission Beach community residential areas generated by a dramatic increase in skateboard activity between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, current skateboard restrictions do not completely address this problem; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to add additional restrictions on skateboard use to minimize disturbances; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VIII, Article 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 84.12, to read as follows:

**SEC. 84.12 USE OF SKATEBOARDS, COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES RESTRICTED**

(a) [No change in text.]

(b) It is unlawful for any person riding on or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle, or similar device to go upon any portion of public rights-of-way within the Mission Beach community, as defined by the Community Planning Area Map, as designated on Map Drawing No. C-637.1, on file in the office of the City

Clerk as Document No. 768482, or to go upon any portion of the most westerly public walkway between San Diego Place on the south and Law Street on the north, known as Ocean Front Walk or Ocean Boulevard, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.


(c) Any person upon roller skates or riding on or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle or similar device on any sidewalk or right of way not open to public vehicular traffic shall exercise due care and shall yield the right of way to pedestrians.

(d) No person shall go upon roller skates or ride on or by means of a coaster, skateboard, toy vehicle or similar device on any sidewalk or right of way not open to public vehicular traffic at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent having due regard for pedestrian traffic and in no event at a speed which endangers the safety of persons or property.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
