ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17871 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON NOV 23 1992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING DIVISION 1, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 104.0100.6, 104.0100.8, 104.0100.10, 104.0100.12 AND 104.0100.14, ALL RELATING TO SPECIAL SIGN DISTRICTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Division 1, Sections 104.0100.6, 104.0100.8, 104.0100.10, 104.0100.12 and 104.0100.14 to read as follows:

SEC. 104.0100.6 Permitted Signs

Regulatory provisions for all signs permitted on either a district-wide basis or on a subdistrict basis for a Special Sign District may be approved or denied by the City Council in accordance with Section 104.0100.16. The following regulatory provisions for signs may be established within a Special Sign District:

a. through q. [No changes.]

SEC. 101.0100.8 Initiation

The establishment, repeal, change in boundaries or change in sign regulations of a Special Sign District may be initiated by the Planning Commission, by the City Council, or by a petition filed with the Planning

Commission in the office of the Planning Department. Said petition shall contain the signatures of the record owners or lessees of record of at least sixty percent (60%) of the commercially and industrially zoned land area lying within the established business district. The petition shall be made upon a prescribed application form which shall be accompanied by such data as may be required.

SEC. 104.0100.10 Decision Process

A. An application filed pursuant to Section 104.0100.8 may be approved or denied by the City Council in accordance with **Process Five** and as set forth in Sections 104.0100.10 - 104.0101.16.

SEC. 104.0100.12 Action by the Planning Commission

The Planning Commission may recommend to the Council by affirmative vote of not less than a majority of its total voting members, the adoption of an ordinance which will accomplish one (1) or more of the following:

A. Incorporate all or a lesser portion of the property described in the notice given pursuant to Chapter XI, Article 1, Division 3 in the Special Sign District and impose special sign regulations.


SEC. 104.0100.14 Hearing set before City Council

In the event the Planning Commission fails to act upon an application the City Council shall, after the expiration of 120 calendar days from the date of the filing of said application, direct that a public hearing be held before the Council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on January 4, 1993. The provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth (30th) day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment or January 4, 1993 whichever occurs last.




