ADOPTED ON DEC 08 1992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4,
DIVISION 5-C, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0545 RELATING TO THE
LEGISLATIVE OFFICERS RETIREMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on June 2, 1992, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-1774 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, a proposition to amend Section 12 of the Charter of The City of San Diego (Proposition A) was passed by a majority of the qualified voters which prohibits any person from serving more than two consecutive four-year terms as Councilmember from any particular district; and

WHEREAS, a proposition to amend Section 24 of the Charter of The City of San Diego (Proposition A) was passed by a majority of the qualified voters which prohibits any person from serving more than two consecutive four-year terms as Mayor; and

WHEREAS, in light of the changes to Charter Sections 12 and 24, in order to advance the theory of the Legislative Officers Retirement Plan and its successful operation by promoting the public purpose of inducing qualified persons to enter and continue in public service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, Division 5-C, of the

San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0545 to read as follows.


SEC. 24.0545 Legislative Officer Age and Service Requirements for Retirement

Upon written application to the Board of Administration, a legislative officer who is a member of this system shall be retired and thereafter shall receive for life the service retirement allowance provided in Section 24.0546 if the member (a) is 60 or more years of age and has 4 or more years of creditable service at retirement, or (b) has 8 or more years of creditable service at an age less than 60 with the retirement allowance reduced by 2% for each year and fractional year under 60.

Section 2. Upon enactment, this ordinance shall be retroactive to July 13, 1992.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance amends Section 24.0545 of the San Diego Municipal Code to change the Legislative Officer age and service requirements for retirement so that a member who has 8 or more years of creditable service is eligible to retire at an age less than 60 with the retirement allowance reduced by 2% for each year and fractional year under 60.
This ordinance is being made retroactive to July 13, 1992, to coincide with the effective date that San Diego City Charter sections 12 and 24 were changed to prohibit any person from serving more than two consecutive four-year terms as Mayor or Councilmember from any particular district.
