RESOLUTION CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR GENERAL WELFARE REQUIRES THE FORMATION OF AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE CROSBY STREET (HARBOR DRIVE TO KEARNY AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal

2. At such hearing all persons interested shall be given an opportunity to be heard and sald hearing may be continued from time to time as may be determined by the City Council. The decision of the City Council as to the formation of the District as described above shall be final and conclusive.
