WHEREAS, the system will comprise 25 task forces; each developed, organized and administered by a sponsoring agency; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Fire Department, in cooperation with other agencies county-wide, will coordinate a 56-member task force to include search, rescue, medical and technical functions; and

WHEREAS, each task force, capable of deployment to a catastrophic disaster site within 6 hours, will provide a self-contained effort to rescue and treat trapped victims; and

WHEREAS, the City will match the \$46,809 provided through FEMA for the purchase of supplies and equipment with the equivalent amount; and

WHEREAS, the State of California will reimburse the City for the purchase of approximately \$24,500 worth of equipment which will be applied to the City's matching amount of \$46,809; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the State of California Office of Emergency Services (OES), for the San Diego Fire Department's participation in the National Urban Search and Rescue Response System as a sponsoring agency, under the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-2793,76 together with any reasonably necessary modifications or amendments thereto which do not increase project scope or cost and which the City Manager shall deem necessary from time to time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this project and agreement.
- 2. That the acceptance of \$46,809 from FEMA for the purchase of supplies and equipment required for participation be and is hereby approved.
- 3. That the City hereby certifies that the amount of \$46,809, available within the Fire Department's FY 1992 budget, to match that of the Federal's contribution, be delayed and split between FY 1993-94.
- 4. That the City Manager, or his authorized representatives, be authorized to act as agent of the City in all negotiations and preparation of documents required for
