RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 279557

ADOPTED ON MAR 16 1992

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPMENT ZONE AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the State of California has adopted waste management goals which shall result in increased efforts to recycle material resources available in municipal wastestreams; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Diego have adopted policies to meet or exceed the State's recycling goals; and

WHEREAS, implementation of these policies shall result in a dramatic increase in amounts of post-consumer material resources available for recycling; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board is promoting the creation of Recycling Market Development Zones in order to attract recycling and remanufacturing businesses that will use those post-consumer material resources; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a San Diego Recycling Market Development Zone within the City and County areas of Otay Mesa would enhance the job creation and economic development goals of the City and County; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a San Diego Recycling Market Development Zone within the City and County areas of Otay Mesa would enhance the environmental and recycling goals of the City and County; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file a joint application in conjunction with the County of San Diego, to be filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-279557, with the State of California, Integrated Waste Management Board, for designation of a portion of the City of San Diego, Otay Mesa Community, as a Recycling Market Development Zone (hereinafter called "application area") in accordance with the procedures and regulations adopted by the California Integrated Waste Management Board.

2. That the application area that is within the City of San Diego shall have the following boundaries:

Starting at the intersection of Otay Valley Road and the boundary line between the City of San Diego and the County of San Diego, then following said boundary line easterly then southerly to the United States and Mexico International Border line, then westerly along the International Border line to a point on the International Border line representing the westernmost area zoned for industrial purposes (as shown on the map filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-16290), then northerly along the line designating the area zoned for industrial purposes to the intersection of Otay Valley Road, then northwesterly along Otay Valley Road to the boundary line between the City of San Diego and the County of San Diego, the point of origination.

3. That the Council of the City of San Diego hereby finds that the economic development and waste management goals and practices of the City of San Diego are favorable to the development of post-consumer waste materials markets, and that

the designation of the application area as a Recycling Market Development Zone is necessary to assist in attracting private sector recycling business investments to the proposed zone.


4. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to review and recommend changes to zoning requirements that may unnecessarily restrict recycling processors and remanufacturers within the application area.

5. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to create a service package designed to attract recycling processors and remanufacturers within the application area.

6. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of San Diego for the joint administration and marketing of such proposed zone, if approved by the State of California.
