A RESOLUTION FORMALLY RECOGNIZING A COMMUNITY PLANNING GROUP FOR THE EASTERN AREA OF THE MID-CITY COMMUNITY BY APPROVAL OF BYLAWS AND INITIAL MEMBERSHIP.

WHEREAS, a committee wishing to be recognized as the Eastern Area Community Planning Committee has submitted bylaws and initial membership to the City Clerk and the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Planning Department and the City Attorney that these bylaws meet the requirements of Council Policy 600-24; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 1992, the Committee of the Whole voted to approve these bylaws as recommended by the City Manager and that the Eastern Area Community Planning Committee follow the regular schedule and procedures for conducting business as a recognized community planning group; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Eastern Area Community Planning Committee be formally recognized by the approval of the bylaws, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR-279732 and that the Eastern Area Community Planning Committee follow the regular schedule and procedures for conducting business as a recognized community planning group.
