WHEREAS, such exceptions threaten the continued viability of the non-discrimination in housing provisions of the FEHA; and

WHEREAS, the Human Relations Commission of The City of San Diego has reviewed <u>Donahue v. Fair Employment and Housing</u>

<u>Commission</u> and recommends that the City take a position against the holding of this case; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council directs the City Attorney to write and file an amicus curiae letter or to sign on to another entity's amicus curiae brief urging the State Supreme Court to reverse the Court of Appeal's decision in Donahue v. Fair Employment and Housing Commission.
