A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AN ANNUAL ASSESSMENT WITHIN PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS FOR JULY 1, 1992 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1993.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council"), in accordance with the Parking and Business

Improvement Association Law of 1989 (Streets and Highways Code section 36500 et seq.) wishes to continue the promotional activities within existing business improvement districts (the "districts"); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council hereby declares its intention to levy and collect an assessment from businesses within established districts for the period from July 1, 1992 to June 30, 1993.
 - 2. That the following districts are to be assessed:

Adams Avenue - generally from 2400 to 3999 block of Adams Avenue; and all adjacent side streets from the 4600 to 4799 block.

City Heights - generally from 3300 to 4799 block of University Avenue; and all adjacent side streets from 3800 to 4099 block.

Downtown - generally all that area within and bounded by
First Avenue through Tenth Avenue, and E Street through Ash
Street.

El Cajon Boulevard - generally from 3300 to 5399 block of El Cajon Boulevard; and adjacent side streets from 33rd Street to 47th Street between 4200 to 4399 block and from Euclid Avenue to Dayton Street between 4300 and 4499 block.

El Cajon Boulevard (Gateway) - generally from 1800 to 3299 block to El Cajon Boulevard; and all adjacent side streets from 4200 to 4399 block.

Gaslamp Quarter - generally from the area located within Broadway and the San Diego and Arizona Railway right-of-way; and between Fourth Avenue and Sixth Avenue.

Hillcrest - generally from Park Boulevard to the east; Front Street to the west, Montecito Street to the north; and Upas Street to the south.

La Jolla - generally Prospect Street from 200 to 1445 block; Ivanhoe Avenue, Herschel Avenue, Girard Avenue and Fay Avenue between Torrey Pines Road and Pearl Street; and from the 1000 block of Torrey Pines Road toward the 400 block of Pearl Street to La Jolla Boulevard including from 7345 to 7606 block of La Jolla Boulevard.

Mission Hills - generally Fort Stockton Drive from 818 to
1112 block, including side streets from Stephens Street to
Albatross Street; between and including Washington Street from
228 to 1794 block; University Avenue from 300 to 1025 block; West

Lewis Street from 328 to 1753 block; and India Street from 3033 to 3753 block.

North Park - generally from 2750 to 3299 block of University Avenue; and all adjacent side streets between the 3800 and 3900 block; Lincoln Avenue from 2750 to 3290 block; and North Parkway from 2850 to 3299 block.

Ocean Beach - generally Newport Avenue from 4800 to 5099 block; Narragansett Avenue, Niagara Avenue and Santa Monica Avenue between portions of 4700 to 5099 block; and portions of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard, Cable Street, Bacon Street and Abbot Street from 1769 to 1976 block.

- 3. That a full report describing each district and activities to be undertaken, including the boundaries of the district and assessment rates during the period of July 1, 1992 through June 30, 1993, is available for review in the office of the City Clerk.
- 4. That notice is hereby given that on June 1, 1992 at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City
 Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, is fixed as the time and place when and where any and all interested persons having a desire to be heard may appear and state their views for or against the continuance of each district or the furnishing of specific types of improvements or activities within each district.

5. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the aforementioned hearing by publication pursuant to Section 36534(b) of the Streets and Highways Code.
