BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court action for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; the federal government, the Office of the United States Attorney General, the Department of Justice, and the Bureau of Justice Assistance disclaim responsibility for any such liability;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
