WHEREAS, the County's jail system is currently under court order (Hudler and Armstrong) not to exceed holding 3,636 prisoners per day; and

WHEREAS, because of serious overcrowding exceeding 180% of rated capacity in the County jail system, almost all misdemeanants are prevented from being booked; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, in an effort to address the misdemeanant booking issue, opened its own Pretrial Misdemeanant Detention Facility in May 1992; and

WHEREAS, the County opened a medium security jail facility for 512 inmates in October 1991; and

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Administrative Officer has proposed funding to fully operate the East Mesa Maximum Security Detention Facility for 1,500 prisoners in fiscal year 1993; NOW, THEREFORE,
