RESOLUTION NUMBER R-280312

ADOPTED ON JULY 7, 1992

WHEREAS, the State of California has experienced an economic recession for two years which has resulted in reduced revenues and increased demand for support services; and

WHEREAS, the State of California is currently projecting a deficit through June 30, 1993 of \$11.7 billion; and

WHEREAS, current State budget deliberations include proposals to divert revenue from local government to the State to balance their budget; and

WHEREAS, the State is withholding money due the City from Vehicle License Fees (\$45 million), Cigarette tax (\$1 million) and Gas Tax (\$19 million); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to withhold payments to the State until its budget matter is resolved subject to the City Attorney's findings that such action is lawful and will not result in fines or penalties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the City Attorney determine that this is legal, the City Manager is directed to contact other large cities throughout California to advise them

of The City of San Diego's action and request that they do the same.
