RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S ELECTIONS, CAMPAIGN AND GOVERNMENTAL ETHICS ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the City Council created the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board by Ordinance No. 0-17720 (New Series), codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 26.1201 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-275742 adopted on May 21, 1990, the City Council determined that all City boards and commissions created by ordinance for a duration of one (1) year or more, among others, should be required to adopt a conflict of interest code and file Statements of Economic Interest forms (730 Forms) with disclosure categories appropriately tailored to reflect the charge of the committee; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regulations section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code; and

WHEREAS, this standard code can be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the FPPC after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board have had an opportunity to review and discuss the proposed conflict of interest code,


including the scope of disclosure categories, as certified by the chair of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regulations section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC are attached to this resolution and are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendix in which members are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the conflict of interest code of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to section (b)(4) of the standard code, designated members shall file statements of economic interests (SEI's) with the secretary of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of the SEI's of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board's members and chair, the secretary of the Elections, Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these SEI's to the office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this conflict of interest code shall become effective upon the date of adoption of this

resolution and that the chair and members of the Elections,

Campaign and Governmental Ethics Advisory Board shall file their

SEI's within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this code.
