WHEREAS, the program consists of North County and San Diego teams representing a cooperative alliance between eight (8) local law enforcement agencies to continue the successful JUDGE Program targeting habitual drug and drug/gang offenders; and

WHEREAS, there is no requirement for matching funds and no additional City personnel or resources will be required to

implement and execute the program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manger be, and is hereby, authorized to accept the Grant Award, as described in the Grant Application Proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{280619}{}$ , to the Office of Criminal Justice Planning, and he is further authorized to execute the grant proposal program, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court action for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; the Federal Government, the Office of Criminal Justice Planning, and the State of California disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
