WHEREAS, the California Chapter of the GPA is comprised entirely of volunteers who accomplish the demanding responsibilities of fundraising, public relations, fostering and transporting dogs and processing applications; and

WHEREAS, GPA's concern for these animals is commendable and their efforts to place these magnificent greyhounds into homes where both the animals and their new owners will be happy are true examples of commitment to the ethical treatment of animals;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
that September 12, 1992 be and it is hereby declared to be  
"GREYHOUND PETS OF AMERICA DAY" in San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council shares the concern  
about, and commitment for, the proper care of greyhounds and that  
Greyhound Pets of America be recognized for their efforts.
