WHEREAS, there is no requirement for matching funds and no additional City Personnel or resources will be required to implement the program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized to submit the

Grant Application Proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk, as Document No. RR-280698, to the National Institute of Justice, and he is further authorized to execute the grant proposal program, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court action for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; the Federal Government, the National Institute of Justice, and the research team disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
