RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 280702

ADOPTED ON SEP 21 1992

WHEREAS, the Police Department of The City of San Diego desires to apply for, and if selected, to accept and expend, a grant award of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) for Phase II of the existing Police Department grant program entitled "Drug Market Analysis Program Cooperative Agreement" from the National Institute of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the grant award would be used to develop and implement new systems to compare traditional narcotics enforcement strategies with problem-oriented or situational approaches, and to measure displacement of narcotics activity; and

WHEREAS, the program will feature cooperation by other area agencies and some regionalization of program application; and

WHEREAS, the program will fund professional and support staff and resources within the Police Department to develop and implement the program; and

WHEREAS, the program requires the continuing sub-contract evaluation by the Police Executive Research Forum, to be funded from grant funds; and

WHEREAS, there is no requirement for matching funds and no additional City personnel or resources will be required to implement the program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,

that the City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized to submit the Grant Application Proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk, as Document No. RR-280702, to the National Institute of Justice; and he is further authorized to execute all aspects of the grant program, any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authority shall include all aspects of the grant program, including personnel selection, purchases, contract services and program activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court action for damages shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; the Federal Government, the National Institute of Justice, and the Police Executive Research Forum disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
