A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE MORENA BOULEVARD (W. MORENA BOULEVARD TO NAPIER STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-289595, a public hearing was called for on 00708 1992 at the hour of 2:00 pm in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

Portion of PL 256, R.O.S. 837, Misc. Map 36; lots 1 & 2 of Laudy's "L" Sub. Map 4016; lots 9-17 of Block 4 of Asher's Clover Leaf Terrace Map 1568; portion of lot 255 of Pueblo Lands MM36; lots 242 & 243 of Bay Park Village Map 2209.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

MORENA BOULEVARD between the northerly line of W. Morena Boulevard and the northerly line of Napier Street; ASHER STREET between the westerly line of Goldfield Street and the easterly line of Morena Boulevard; LITTLEFIELD STREET between the easterly

line of Morena Boulevard; ALLEY IN BAY PARK VILLAGE, Map 2209
between the easterly line of Morena Boulevard and a line parallel
to and 50 feet east of the easterly line of Morena Boulevard;
ASHTON STREET between the easterly line of Morena Boulevard and a
line 50 feet east of the easterly line of Morena Boulevard
all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 26590-D entitled
"MORENA BOULEVARD (W. MORENA BOULEVARD TO NAPIER STREET)
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the
office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-280595 and
attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego

Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to

all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.


