WHEREAS, Arab-Americans occupy positions of leadership and—responsibility in San Diego City government, and throughout our system of government, setting a fine example of public service at the local, state, and national level, and have also enriched our Nation with the quiet power of strong families and contributing communities, many having come to the United States in search of the blessings of peace and freedom; and

WHEREAS, industrious and determined, Arab-Americans have helped give us a more profound understanding of the rights and responsibilities we have as citizens of a free and prosperous Nation, yet they have not forgotten their ancestral homelands,

and have joined all Americans in the desire to bring peace and security to that troubled region; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is proud to recognize its newest employee group, the Association of Arab-American Employees (SDCAAAE), members of which represent every Arab county and religion; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims October 25, 1992, to be the first annual "ARAB-AMERICAN DAY" in San Diego, in recognition of the contributions of Arab-Americans, and encourages all residents to share and enjoy the festivities and cultural significance of this day.
