WHEREAS, on April 12, 1989 the California Coastal Commission agreed to a City of San Diego request for an extension of time to keep the sludge drying facilities on Fiesta Island, establishing a \$1,000,000 mitigation fund; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1992 the Coastal Commission once again granted a one-year extension and increased the amount of the mitigation fund payment to \$2,000,000 for Fiscal Year 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's recommendation for fund allocation varies from the Coastal Commission recommendation, with the proposed allocation to be \$550,000 in excess of the Fiscal Year 1993 allocation, but is possible by deferring two previously approved new restroom projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to propose to the California Coastal Commission a \$2,550,000 Sludge Mitigation Fund expenditure allocation for Fiscal Year 1993.
