WHEREAS, there is no present or prospective use for the street either for the public street system, for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

- 1. That Black Mountain Road, Old Survey 124, Road Survey 451, New Survey No. 3 and an unnamed 60-foot-wide County road easement, in connection with Black Mountain Ranch North (TM 91-0313) and Black Mountain Ranch South (TM 90-0332), which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 2. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the combined final map for Black Mountain Ranch North (TM 91-0313) and Black Mountain Ranch South (TM 90-0332) has been approved by Council action. In the event that the final map is not approved within the time allowance specified under the tentative map conditions or any subsequent time extensions allowed, this resolution shall become void and be of no further force or effect.
- 3. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the completion of the aforementioned final map, and the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with

drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
