RESOLUTION NUMBER R-281081 ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 17, 1992

RESOLUTION IMPOSING INTERIM IMPACT FEES IN THE NORTH CITY FUTURE URBANIZING AREA.

WHEREAS, the City has begun planning for the future development of the City's North City Future Urbanizing Area; and

WHEREAS, the City and the California Government Code require that impact fees be based upon and in mitigation of the impacts of new development upon infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, there are current proposals for development within the North City Future Urbanizing Area which if approved would be placing burdens on the North City Future Urbanizing Area and the City infrastructure without the payment of appropriate or any impact fees; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the planning process at this early stage is not as precise as other areas of the City due to the options available for the development of the North City Future Urbanizing Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has, based upon the criteria of state law, City policy and the current planning alternatives, developed an interim schedule of fees for development in the proposed land use categories to be utilized in the North City Future Urbanizing Area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the interim fees contained in Exhibit A attached hereto are hereby determined to be the appropriate impact fees for the land uses described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the impact fees for future years in the North City Future Urbanizing Area shall be annually adjusted for inflation as set forth in Attachment B, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference.
