- 3. That the Council hereby certifies that the project is compatible with land use plans for the jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project.
- 4. That the Council hereby appoints the City Manager, or his duly authorized representative, as agent of The City of San Diego to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments and billing statements, which may be necessary for the completion of this project.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to establish a separate interest earning fund for this grant if funded.
