RESOLUTION NUMBER R- $\frac{281160}{1992}$

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE SUNSET CLIFFS BOULEVARD (BRIGHTON AVENUE TO NEWPORT AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-2607231, a public hearing was called for on 201271392 at the hour of 2000 in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

All of Block 32 (lots 1-48), lots 47-48 of
Block 31, lots 47 and 48 of Block 30, lots 23 through
26 of Block 53, lots 23 and 24 of Block 54, lots 23 and
24 of Block 55, lots 23 through 26 of Block 56 of Ocean
Beach Map 279.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

SUNSET CLIFFS BOULEVARD between the northerly line of Newport Avenue to the northerly line of Brighton Avenue; Santa Monica Avenue from the southwesterly line

of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest of the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and between the northeasterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard to a line parallel to and 200 feet northeast; ALLEY BLOCK 54 between the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest; SARATOGA AVENUE between the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest and between the northeasterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet northeast; ALLEY BLOCK 55 between the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest; CAPE MAY AVENUE between a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest of the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard to a line parallel to and 50 feet northeast of the northeasterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard; ALLEY BLOCK 56 between a line parallel to and 50 feet southwest of the southwesterly line of Sunset Cliffs Boulevard;

all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 25957-D entitled "SUNSET CLIFFS BOULEVARD (BRIGHTON AVENUE TO NEWPORT AVENUE)

UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT, " copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI,

Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.

The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.


