AN EMERGENCY INTERIM ORDINANCE REGULATING ADVERTISING DISPLAYS.

WHEREAS, on July 19, 1983, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. O-16009 which provided interim regulations of advertising displays for a period of 120 days; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing on September 27, 1983, at which it considered public testimony on alternative amendments to the City-wide On-premises Sign regulations; and

WHEREAS, it was requested at said public hearing that the matter be continued to allow for further development of evidence concerning the impacts of the proposed alternative amendments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council continued the consideration of the alternative amendments to December 6, 1983; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the effective period of the Interim Ordinance Regulating Advertising Displays (Ordinance No. O-16009) in order to retain the interim regulations during the period of the continuance and for a period sufficient to enable the City Council to enact permanent regulations; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code, Section 65858 authorizes the City Council to conduct a public hearing, noticed pursuant to California Government Code, Section 65856, for the purpose of extending an interim ordinance enacted pursuant to California Government Code, Section 65858; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, on October 18, 1983, conducted such a noticed public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter X, Article 1, Divisions 4 and 11 of the San Diego Municipal Code to the contrary, any sign permitted by the aforesaid Divisions, other than a ground sign, as defined in Municipal Code, Section 101.1101.70, may be utilized for the display of a message without limitation on the content of such message.
- 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its introduction and shall expire on February 21, 1984.
