AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17781 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1992-93 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-17781, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE RETIREMENT DEPARTMENT TO EXEMPT THE POSITION OF INVESTMENT OFFICER FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the addition of an Investment Officer position in the Retirement Department for the fiscal year 1991-92 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Administrator is requesting that this position be exempted from the classified service in accordance with section 117 of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that
"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for
formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"
may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon
first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil
Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, a review of the position indicates the nature and duties of said position is consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter section 117(a)17; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that said position be exempted from the Classified Service pursuant to the Charter provisions;

and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on December 10, 1992, and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated December 15, 1992 attached hereto as Attachment A, the Investment Officer position for the Retirement Department (088) be and is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 0-17781 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1992-993 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. 00-17781, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule of the Retirement Department (088) to reflect therein the Investment Officer position as being in the unclassified service.

Section 3. That as a schedule of compensation for the above

unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Salary Rates 07.7, 07.8 and 07.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 0-17781 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT:

Exemption of an New Investment Officer Position from the Classified

Service

On December 10, 1992, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Retirement Administrator to exempt an Investment Officer position from the Classified Service. This position will perform daily administration and management of a \$1.1 billion investment program for the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the administrative and managerial duties and responsibilities of this position, the Commission finds that it meets the intent of Charter Section 117. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
