AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 102.0204 RELATING TO PARCEL MAPS.

WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day," and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Development Department has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code section 102.0204 having to do with Parcel Maps, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 2, Division 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 102.0204 to read as follows:

SEC. 102.0204 Parcel Maps

The preparation, content and form of parcel maps shall conform to Chapter 2, Article 3 of the Subdivision Map Act.

Outstanding assessment bonds against the property must be paid in full or the bond split in accordance with the new lots. A letter from the bond holder indicating consent to any bond split will be required.

Easements of record within the property being subdivided shall be shown on the map together with applicable recording data.

Dedications or offers of dedication, when required, may be made either by separate instrument or by certificate on the parcel map. Where such dedications are made by certificate, the City Manager may accept or reject the dedications, as authorized by Section 66463(b) of the Subdivision Map Act.

Except as otherwise provided in this Article, all parcel maps shall be based upon a field survey made in conformity with the Land Surveyors Act.

New parcel lines created by the parcel map are to be monumented in a manner pursuant to Section 102.0412. These monuments are to be shown on the parcel map, together with their relationship to all existing monuments in the area that were used to establish the new monument locations.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
