AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XI, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 10, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 111.1030 RELATING TO REVERSIONS, VACATIONS AND ABANDONMENTS.

WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day," and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Development Department has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code section 111.1030 having to do with reversions, vacations and abandonments, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter XI, Article 1, Division 10, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 111.1030 to read as follows:

SEC. 111.1030 Reversions, Vacations and Abandonments

- (a) [No change.]
- (b) Procedure. Reversions are processed pursuant to Chapter 6, Article 1, of the "Subdivision Map Act" by either an application for reversion or by resubdivision. Vacations and abandonments are

processed by either filing an application for vacation or abandonment pursuant to Streets and Highways Code sections 8300-8363 or by resubdivision.

- (1) Application Process. an application for a reversion, vacation, or abandonment shall be filed with the City Engineer in accordance with Municipal Code section 111.0202.
- (A) Decision Process. An application for a reversion, vacation, or abandonment may be approved or denied by resolution of the City Council in accordance with "Process Five," with the following exceptions:
 - (i) through iii) [No changes.]
- (iv) Abandonment of a public service easement shall be noticed in accordance with Streets and Highways Code section 8322.
 - (B) and (C) [No changes.]
 - (2) [No change.]

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
