AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 71.0102 RELATING TO DEFINITIONS AND SECTION 71.0103 RELATING TO PHASING.

WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day," and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Development Department has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code sections 71.0102 and 71.0103 having to do with Transportation Demand Management, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 71.0102 to read as follows:

SEC. 71.0102 DEFINITIONS

- A. through D. [No changes.]
- E. "Employer" shall mean a sole proprietor, partnership, corporation, unincorporated association, joint venture, or other business entity that employs 60 or more employees.

F. through L. [No changes.]

Section 2. That Chapter VII, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by Section 71.0103 to read as follows:

SEC. 71.0103 PHASING

This Division shall be implemented in phases as follows:

- A. <u>Employer</u> Phasing for Employers shall be effective six months from the Implementation Date.
- B. <u>Building Owner</u> Phasing for Building Owners shall be effective six months from the Implementation Date.
- C. <u>Developer</u> Phasing for Developers shall be effective on the Implementation Date for Developers applying for discretionary permits after the Implementation Date.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This Division shall be implemented in phases as follows:

- A. Intermediate Employer Phasing for Intermediate

 Employers shall be effective four years and six months from the

 Implementation Date.
- B. <u>Large Employer</u> Phasing for Large Employers shall be effective six months from the Implementation Date.
- E. B. Building Owner Phasing for Building Owners shall be effective six months from the Implementation Date.

Developer - Phasing for Developers shall be effective on the Implementation Date for Developers applying for discretionary permits after the Implementation Date.
