AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 85, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 91.8507 RELATING TO SECURITY REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day"; and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate, where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspection Department has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code section 91.8507 having to do with surety bond requirements, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; and

WHEREAS, section 40 of the City Charter provides that the City Attorney shall prepare in writing all bonds concerning the City and to endorse on each approval of the form or correctness thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney shall prepare the form to be used by the City for the surety bonds or other form of security to be accepted by the City pursuant to section 91.8507; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IX, Article 1, Division 85, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 91.8507, to read as follows:

SEC. 91.8507 Security Requirements

- (a) Before the Building Official issues a Removal or Relocation Permit the applicant shall first be required to deposit with the City of San Diego a Surety bond, issued by a Surety company authorized to do business in the State of California, or other form of security, approved by the Building Official. The surety bond or other form of security shall be on a form that has been approved by the City Attorney and shall be in an amount equal to the actual cost of the work to be performed plus twenty— five percent (25%) of that amount to insure the satisfactory performance and completion of such work. The actual cost of the work shall be determined by the Building Official.

The Surety bond or other form of security shall be approved by the Building Official.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
