AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, CALLING, PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 ON SEPTEMBER 21, 1993 FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER, COUNCIL DISTRICT 8, AND CONSOLIDATING THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION WITH THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held in Council District Eight (8) on Tuesday, February 16, 1993, for the purpose of filling a vacancy in the office of Councilmember for District No. 8, which vacancy was created by the resignation of the incumbent Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 12, the candidate receiving the greatest number of votes at the Special Election was deemed to be elected to the vacant office; and

WHEREAS, the person elected at the Special Election to fill the vacancy shall hold office only until the next regular Municipal Election, at which time a person shall be elected under the provisions of Charter section 10 to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term, that is, until December 4, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the next regular Municipal Election will be September 21, 1993 (the Primary Election for Council Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7), and November 2, 1993 (the General Election for Council Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, California, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Special Municipal Primary Election be held in Council District Eight (8) on Tuesday, September 21, 1993, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following office:

COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 8 two-year term

Section 2. The Special Municipal Primary Election called for September 21, 1993 in Council District 8 is hereby ordered consolidated with the Municipal Primary Election in the City of San Diego on the same date.

Section 3. For the purpose of the Special Municipal Primary Election on September 21, 1993, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for the Special Municipal Primary Election.

Section 5. That the polls for the Special Municipal Primary Election shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 21, 1993.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment supplies and other printed matter.

Section 7. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for the Special Municipal Primary Election.

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Judges	\$35.00
Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

\*Compensation provides for ballot box returns

Section 8. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 9. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of the City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
