ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17933 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JUN 14 1993

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 1993.

WHEREAS, a Charter Amendment known as Proposition E was approved by the voters in November 1992; and

WHEREAS, commencing with the year 1996, the municipal elections to the office of Councilmembers for Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7 shall be held on the same dates as the California State primary and general elections for that year; and

WHEREAS, at the municipal primary and general elections in 1993, Councilmembers for Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7 shall be chosen by the electors for a term of three (3) years; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, September 21, 1993, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 1 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 3 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 5 three-year term
- COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 7 three-year term

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said election.

Section 4. That the polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 21, 1993.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 6. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

*Compensation provides for ballot box returns.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 8. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
