AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 71.0108 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT PLAN REQUIREMENTS FOR EMPLOYERS OF FEWER THAN 100 EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Article 1, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 71.0108 to read as follows:

SEC. 71.0108 TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT PLAN REQUIREMENTS

If an Employer fails to reach its EDAR targets for two successive years, the Employer shall develop, file, and implement a Transportation Demand Management Plan in accordance with the Technical Requirements. This section does not apply to Employers of fewer than 100 employees per work site.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
