AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X1, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 111.0302 AND 111.0306 RELATING TO NOTICES.

WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day"; and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate, where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has reviewed San Diego Municipal Code sections 111.0302 and 111.0306 having to do with notices, and has suggested several amendments to these code sections to streamline the regulatory process; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter XI, Article 1, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 111.0302, to read as follows:

SEC. 111.0302 Notice By Mail

- (a) [No changes to this subsection]
- (b) Persons Entitled to Notice. Except as provided in Section 111.0302(c), the "Notice of Application," "Notice of Future Decision" and "Notice of Public Hearing" shall be mailed to the following:

- (1) the "Applicant"; and
- (2) the owners of any real property, as shown on the latest equalized assessment roll of the San Diego County Assessor, located within three hundred feet (300') of the exterior boundaries of the real property that is the subject of the application.
- (3) the "Community Planning Group(s)," if any, that represents the area in which the project is located; and
- (4) any person who has, by written request, asked to be notified of the project.
- (c) Advertised Notice. If the total number of owners to whom notice would be mailed in accordance with Municipal Code section 111.0302(b) is greater than 1,000, notice may be accomplished by placing a display advertisement of at least one-eighth page in a newspaper of general daily circulation within the City.
 - (d) Notice Address.
 - (1) A notice to the "Applicant" shall be mailed to the address shown on the application or as indicated on a written change of address form filed by the "Applicant" with the City.
 - (2) A notice to each owner of real property located within three hundred feet (300') of the real property that is the subject of the application shall be mailed to the last known name and address of each owner as shown on the latest equalized assessment roll of the San Diego County Assessor.

Section 2. That Chapter X1, Article 1, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 111.0306, to read as follows:

SEC. 111.0306 Notice for Coastal Development Permits

When a "Coastal Development Permit" is to be considered at a public hearing the "Responsible Department" shall mail a "Notice of Public Hearing" to: (1) the "Coastal Commission"; and (2) all persons requesting notice on "Coastal Development Permits"; and (3) all tenant addresses located within one hundred feet (100') of the exterior boundaries of the real property that is the subject of the application, including each address within a condominium and an apartment complex; and (4) the persons entitled to receive notice as described in Municipal Code section 111.0302(b). A notice mailed to a tenant address shall be addressed to Resident. This notice shall be provided in addition to the other notice provisions of this Division. Notices for appealable Coastal Development Permits shall include provisions for appeals to the Coastal Commission.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 111.0302 Notice By Mail

- (a) [No changes to this subsection]
- (b) Persons Entitled to Notice. Except as provided in Section 111.0302(c), the "Notice of Application," "Notice of Future Decision" and "Notice of Public Hearing" shall be mailed to the following:
 - (1) the "Applicant"; and
 - (2) all tenant addresses located within three hundred feet (300') of the exterior boundaries of the real property that is the subject of the application, including each address within a condominium or apartment complex; and
 - (32) the owners of any real property, as shown on the latest equalized assessment roll of the San Diego County Assessor, located within three hundred feet (300') of the exterior boundaries of the real property that is the subject of the application.
 - (43) the "Community Planning Group(s)," if any, that represents the area in which the project is located; and
 - (54) any person who has, by written request, asked to be notified of the project.

(c) Advertised Notice. If the combined total number of tenant addresses and owners to whom notice would be mailed in accordance with Municipal Code section 111.0302(b) is greater than 1,000, notice may be accomplished by placing a display advertisement of at least one-eighth page in a newspaper of general daily circulation within the City.

(d) Notice Address.

- (1) A notice to the "Applicant" shall be mailed to the address shown on the application or as indicated on a written change of address form filed by the "Applicant" with the City.
- (2) A notice to each owner of real property located within three hundred feet (300') of the real property that is the subject of the application shall be mailed to the last known name and address of each owner as shown on the latest equalized assessment roll of the San Diego County Assessor.
- (3) A notice mailed to a tenent address shall be addressed "Resident."

SEC. 111.0306 Notice for Coastal Development Permits

When a "Coastal Development Permit" is to be considered at a public hearing the "Responsible Department" shall mail a "Notice of Public Hearing" to: (1) the "Coastal Commission"; and (2) all persons requesting notice on "Coastal Development Permits"; and (3) all tenant addresses located within one hundred feet (100%) of the exterior boundaries of the real property that is the subject of the application, including each address within a condominium and an apartment complex; and (4) the persons

entitled to receive notice as described in Municipal Code section 111.0302(b). A notice mailed to a tenant address shall be addressed to Resident. This notice shall be provided in addition to the other notice provisions of this Division. Notices for appealable Coastal Development Permits shall include provisions for appeals to the Coastal Commission.
