ADOPTED ON OCT 25 1993

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1,
DIVISION 13, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 101.1303 RELATING TO
LIGHT POLLUTION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 13, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.1303, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.1303 Definitions

For purposes of this Division:

(a) "Automatic Timing Device" means a device which automatically turns on and off outdoor light fixtures or circuits. Photo-controls are not considered automatic timing devices for purposes of this Division.

(b) "Light Pollution" means artificial light which causes a detrimental effect on the environment, astronomical research, enjoyment of the night sky or causes undesirable glare or unnecessary illumination of adjacent properties.

(c) "Luminous Tube Lighting" means gas-filled tubing which, when subjected to high voltage, becomes luminescent in a color characteristic of the particular gas used, e.g., neon, argon, etc.

(d) "Outdoor Light Fixtures" means an illuminating device which is permanently installed outdoors, including, but not limited to, devices used to illuminate on and off premises signs.


(e) "Shielding" means a technique or method of construction which causes light emitted from an outdoor light fixture to be projected below an imaginary horizontal plane passing through the fixtures.

(f) "Full Shielding" means a technique or method of construction which causes all light emitted from an outdoor fixture to be projected below an imaginary horizontal plane passing through the lowest point on the fixtures from which light is emitted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 101.1303 Definitions

For purposes of this Division:

A. ~~(a) "AUTOMATIC TIMING DEVICE"~~ **Automatic Timing Device** means a device which automatically turns on and off outdoor light fixtures or circuits. Photo-controls are not considered automatic timing devices for purposes of this Division.

B. ~~(b) "LIGHT POLLUTION"~~ **Light Pollution** means artificial light which causes a detrimental effect on the environment, astronomical research, enjoyment of the night sky or causes undesirable glare or unnecessary illumination of adjacent properties.

C. ~~(c) "LUMINOUS TUBE LIGHTING"~~ **Luminous Tube Lighting** means means gas-filled tubing which, when subjected to high voltage, becomes luminescent in a color characteristic of the particular gas used, e.g., neon, argon, etc.

D. ~~(d) "OUTDOOR LIGHT FIXTURES"~~ **Outdoor Light Fixtures** means an illuminating device which is permanently installed outdoors, including, but not limited to, devices used to illuminate on and off premises signs.

E. ~~(e) "SHIELDING"~~ **Shielding** means a technique or method of construction which causes light emitted from an outdoor light fixture to be projected below an imaginary

horizontal plane passing through the fixtures.

(f) "Full Shielding" means a technique or method of construction which causes all light emitted from an outdoor fixture to be projected below an imaginary horizontal plane passing through the lowest point on the fixtures from which light is emitted.
