AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101; AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18, BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801; AND BY AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 19, BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1901, ALL RELATING TO CHANGING THE NAME OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS AND RELATED MATTERS..

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.0101, to read as follows:

SEC. 22.0101 Permanent Rules of the Council

Rule 1 through 14. [No change.]

Rule 15. Committee Staff

A committee consultant from the Committee Consultant
Activity of the Department of Intergovernmental Relations
shall be assigned to each standing committee other than the
Rules Committee to provide staff assistance to the
committee. A committee consultant shall be assigned to the
Rules Committee from the office of the Mayor. All committee
consultants shall be subject to appointment and removal by
the chairpersons of their respective committees. Committee
consultants, in addition to the duties assigned to them by

the committee, shall, when directed by the committee chairperson, prepare an objective informational analysis addressing both the policy and fiscal considerations of any matter that is reviewed by the committee. Such consultant analysis shall be attached to the resolution or ordinance when it is delivered to the Rules Committee for listing on the Adoption Agenda of the docket. All committee consultants shall cooperate fully in providing staff assistance to each standing committee during the authorized absence of any committee consultant.

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 18, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.1801 to read as follows:

Section 3. That Chapter II, Article 2, Division 19, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.1901 to read as follows:

DIVISION 19

Department of Intergovernmental Relations SEC. 22.1901 Department of Intergovernmental Relations

- A. The Department of Intergovernmental Relations is a City department. The Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be selected by the Mayor. The Director shall be the appointing authority of all personnel authorized in the department except as stated in Rule 15 of the Permanent Rules of Council. The Director shall be responsible for planning, recommending, coordinating and administering a state and federal legislative program for The City of San Diego in accordance with legislative guidelines established by City Council Policy. The department shall provide legislative coordination and liaison and, in consultation with City departments, City organized or created entities, and other sources:
 - (1) through (7). [No change.]

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1, OF THE 8AN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.0101; AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18, BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801; AND BY AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 19, BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1901, ALL RELATING TO CHANGING THE NAME OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS AND RELATED MATTERS.

This ordinance amends San Diego Municipal Code ("SDMC") section 22,1901 to change the name of the Legislative Services Department to the Department of Intergovernmental Relations, it requires the Department of Intergovernmental Relations to operate its programs in accordance with egislative guidelines established by City Council Policy, it provides that the Director of the Department of Intergovernmental Relations is to be appointed by the Mayor.

§ This ordinance makes companion amendments to SDMC section 22,0101 (Rule 15) and SDMC section 22,1801 made necessary by the amendments to SDMC section 22,1801.
