WHEREAS, the provisions of Council Policy No. 600-15 require that a notice public hearing be conducted before the City Council prior to the vacation of a City street; and

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements by City Council resolution where for a period of five consecutive years the street or highway has been impassable for vehicular travel and no money was expended for maintenance on the street or highway during such period; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve a certain easement; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of Ingelow Street, southeast of Plum Street, adjacent to Lot 11 and Lot 12, Block 71 of Map 165, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation or abandonment is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the public street system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; and

WHEREAS, the adjacent property owners have voluntarily agreed to a building-restricted easement deed over the area to be vacated in order to appease the concerns of the neighborhood and the Peninsula Community Planning Board; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That Ingelow Street, southeast of Plum Street, adjacent to Lot 11 and Lot 12, Block 71 of Map 165, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17969-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-281359, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 2. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, general utilities and franchise facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, together

with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of Encroachment Permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners' underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines.

- 3. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above-described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.
- 4. That the easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along, and across Ingelow Street and that the easement is more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17969-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{281359}{}$ .

5. That the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


