WHEREAS, in 1991, the City Council directed the City Manager through the Park and Recreation Department to institute a fee for unattended displays in the Organ Pavilion; and


WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department met with members of the public for the purpose of receiving input regarding the proposed fee; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to charge a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day titled "Organ Pavilion Unattended Display Fee," which is to be included in the Park and Recreation Department's Fee Schedule.
