Officer's Citation for his tenacity, courage, and professionalism
in February 1989 when he arrested a suspect in East San Diego who
had shot at the intended victim more than ten times; and

WHEREAS, Officer Pecoraro is devoted to his wife Penny; daughter Jessica, 8 years old; and son Eric, 6 years old; who also love Ajax very much; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 1993, Officer Pecoraro and his partner

Ajax were wounded in the performance of their duties while

attempting to apprehend an armed fleeing felon; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends Officer Frank Pecoraro and Police Service Dog Ajax for their dedication to the citizens of The City of San Diego through their demonstrated bravery and performance above and beyond the call of duty, in the highest tradition of the San Diego Police Department.
