OFFICIAL INTENT RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Official Intent Resolution is as follows:

Section 1. The City reasonably expects to reimburse the capital expenditures described herein with the proceeds of lease/purchase obligation to be incurred by the City (the "Reimbursement Lease").

Section 2. This declaration of official intention is made pursuant to Section 1.103-18 of the Income Tax Regulations promulgated by the United States Department of the Treasury.

Section 3. The maximum principal amount of the Reimbursement Lease(s) expected to be entered into is one million dollars.

Section 4. The expenditures with respect to which the City reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of the Reimbursement Lease(s) are for furnishings.

Section 5. The expenditures with respect to which the City reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of the Reimbursement Lease(s) will be made from monies within the allocated reserve (fund 901) and non-departmental (fund 601).

Section 6. The City intends to enter into the Reimbursement Lease(s) within one year of the date such capital expenditures described herein are paid or placed in service.

Section 7. The City shall allocate on its books the Reimbursement Lease(s) proceeds to the capital expenditures described herein.

Section 8. The capital expenditures to be reimbursed as described herein will be made approximately December, 1992 through April, 1993.

Section 9. The City will not use any reimbursed funds to pay debt service or to pay previously financed expenditures and represents that the reimbursement does not constitute any type of artifice or device to avoid arbitrage yield or rebate requirements.
