## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 281714 ADOPTED ON MAR 30 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CERTIFYING THAT THE COUNCIL HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE MASTER ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND THE SECONDARY STUDY WITH RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND JONATHAN SEGAL, AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS OF THE DEVELOPMENT PURSUANT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Agency has previously prepared, and the Agency (Resolution No. 2081) and the City Council (Resolution No. R-279875) have certified the Final Master Environmental Impact Report for the Centre City Redevelopment Project (referred to herein as the "MEIR"); and

WHEREAS, the Council proposes to approve a Disposition and Development Agreement between the Agency and Jonathan Segal (the "Developer") for the sale of certain property in the Project area to the Developer for the construction of a residential condominium development; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the property and the construction of the residential condominium development thereon pursuant to the

provisions of the proposed Disposition and Development Agreement between the Agency and Developer is a redevelopment implementation activity whose environmental impacts are assessed in the MEIR; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc., acting on behalf of the Agency, has prepared a Secondary Study in accordance with and pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) and state and local regulations and guidelines adopted pursuant thereto and such Secondary Study assesses the environmental impacts of the sale and development of real property pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the environmental effects of the proposed development as shown in the MEIR and the Second Study; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council hereby certifies that the Secondary Study of environmental impacts with respect to the proposed sale and development of the real property pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement has been prepared and completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) and state and local regulations and guidelines adopted pursuant thereto and that the Agency has certified thereto.
- 2. That the Council hereby further certifies that the information contained in the Secondary Study and the MEIR has been reviewed and considered by the members of the Council.

- 3. That the Council hereby finds and determines that:
- a. No substantial changes are proposed in the Centre City Redevelopment Project, or with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is to be undertaken, as a result of the sale and development of real property pursuant to the Disposition and Development Agreement, which will require important revisions in the MEIR for the Project, due to the involvement of new significant environmental impacts not covered in the MEIR; and
- b. No new information of substantial importance to the Project has become available which was not known or could not have been known at the time the MEIR for the Project was certified as complete, and which shows that the Project will have any significant effects not discussed previously in the MEIR, or that any significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in the MEIR, or that any mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible or not previously considered would substantially reduce or lessen any significant effects of the Project on the environment; and
- c. No negative declaration, or subsequent environmental impact report, or supplement or addendum to the MEIR is necessary or required; and
