RESOLUTION NUMBER R-281752

ADOPTED ON APRIL 13, 1993

WHEREAS, the Balboa Park East Mesa Precise Plan was approved by the Historical Site Board on April 29, 1992, by the Park and Recreation Board on June 18, 1992, and by the Planning Commission on July 30, 1992; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Council Policy 600-7 provides that public hearings to consider revisions of the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO may be scheduled concurrently with public hearings on proposed community plan amendments; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 65361 provides that mandatory elements of the GENERAL PLAN may not be amended more than four times per year; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to consider amendments of the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO at hearings which are conducted on a semiannual basis; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to conduct a public hearing on proposed actions that will result in changes to the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN during the year, but that such changes shall not become effective until enacted at the semi-annual hearings conducted for the purpose of amending the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that in accordance with the recommendations contained in City Manager's Report No. 92-254, the Council hereby approves the Balboa Park East Mesa Precise Plan, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-281752, with the following amendments:

a) include Alternative 5-2 in the East Mesa Neighborhood Traffic Study for the Pershing Drive and Upas Street Realignment in the northeast corner of the park;


b) keep the 26th Street access to the park open in the southeast corner of the park; and

c) replace the language on page 93 of the Design Concept portion of the Balboa Park East Mesa Precise Plan to read:

if assessments indicate that the current stop signs do not adequately control vehicular speeds and allow for safe pedestrian crossings between the clubhouse and the nine hole golf course, other measures to control vehicular speed should be considered with community input.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the BALBOA PARK EAST MESA PRE-CISE PLAN shall become effective upon adoption of an appropriate amendment of the PROGRESS GUIDE AND GENERAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO incorporating said plan at the next scheduled omnibus hearing.
