## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-281753 ADOPTED ON APRIL 13, 1993

WHEREAS, the Torrey Pines Gliderport, located west of Torrey Pine Road, north of Torrey Pines Scenic Drive and south of Torrey Pines Golf Course and Torrey Pines State Park (portions of Pueblo Lots 1321-1326), is a unique historical resource in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the property that the Torrey Pines Gliderport is occupied on is owned by The Regents of the University of San Diego and The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Historical Site Board designed the City-owned portion of the Torrey Pines Gliderport on the basis of its historic contributions to aviation, its being a natural landing site integrating wind, cliff, cloud and sea and its being a unique treasure and landmark of local and natural significance; and

WHEREAS, the Historical Site Board requested that the Council of The City of San Diego consider recommending that the entire Torrey Pines Gliderport be listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the significance of the Torrey Pines Gliderport pertains to both the State and City owned portions of this property; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 1993, the Council of The City of San Diego held a public hearing to consider endorsing the nomination of the Torrey Pines Gliderport to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, after considering the staff report, and hearing public testimony on the matter, the City Council made its determination; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council hereby recommends to the State Historic Preservation Commission that the portion of the Torrey Pines Gliderport owned by The City of San Diego be listed on the National Register of Historic Places. As to the portion owned by The Regents of the University of California, the Council took no action.
- 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to work with appropriate persons from the University of California, San Diego ("UCSD") and the Torrey Pines Soaring Council to see if a compromise can be reached regarding any future development of the thirty (30) acres of the Torrey Pines Gliderport owned by UCSD, that takes into account the needs of UCSD but is compatible with historic preservation of the site.
