WHEREAS, the City of San Diego wishes to apply for, and if selected, to accept and expend, a grant award of two hundred forty-five thousand and two hundred forty-two dollars (\$245,242.00) for a program entitled "Fraudulent Telemarketing Prevention Project" from the Telecommunications Education Trust of the California Public Utilities Commission, from funds made available by Pacific Bell; and

WHEREAS, the grant award will be used to implement a program designed to educate the public about fraudulent, misleading, and unfair telemarketing practices, especially as these relate to charitable telephone solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the grant award will also be used to research and develop legislation to regulate the operation of telephone solicitation operations commonly known as "boiler rooms"; and

WHEREAS, there is no requirement for matching funds, and all program staff and operations will be paid by grant funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized to submit the Grant Application Proposal, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 281812 , to the Telecommunications Education Trust of the California Public Utilities Commission; and is further authorized to accept and

execute the grant proposal program, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the authority of the City
Manager shall include all aspects of program operation and
expenditures, including personnel selection, purchases, and
activities under the terms and conditions of the approved grant
program proposal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court action for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency; the Telecommunications Education Trust, the California Public Utilities Commission, and Pacific Bell disclaim responsibility for an such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that personnel positions funded by this grant award are not subject to local hiring freezes.
