WHEREAS, "Searching for San Diego" has been conceived as a community effort, spearheaded by the California Council for the Humanities, that will make a major contribution to the public life of this city; and

WHEREAS, "Searching for San Diego" will encompass the variety of experiences that characterizes this city through the kaleidoscope of individual lives in five of its historic and highly differentiated neighborhoods: Emerald Hills, the Gaslamp Quarter, La Jolla, Linda Vista, and Sherman Heights; and

WHEREAS, the goal of "Searching for San Diego" is to promote an informed exploration of "a sense of belonging" as it pertains to civic life in San Diego, fostering dialogue that creates bridges between sometimes disparate groups and individuals; and

WHEREAS, "Searching for San Diego" has been the catalyst for bringing a wide array of cultural, scholarly and neighborhood organizations together to share resources as they address common civic concerns; and

WHEREAS, the performances, reading, discussions, tours and other events that comprise "Searching for San Diego" are made accessible to all without charge by the California Council for the Humanities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego,

hereby commends the California Council for the Humanities and collaborating San Diego organizations for their contribution to the civic life of this city.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the period from April 24 to June 4, 1993, which coincides with the span of events comprising "Searching for San Diego" shall be proclaimed "**SEARCHING FOR SAN DIEGO**" days in San Diego.
