WHEREAS, May 18, 1993, has been declared "Regulatory Relief Day," and

WHEREAS, one purpose of Regulatory Relief Day is to streamline and consolidate where appropriate, the City's land use and environmental regulatory procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering and Development Department has reviewed the <u>Technical Requirements of The City of San Diego</u>

<u>Transportation Demand Management Ordinance</u>, and has suggested several amendments to the code section to streamline the regulatory process; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has introduced amendments to the Transportation Demand Management Ordinance (Chapter VII, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code), deleting Intermediate Employers and raising the minimum employer size affected by the ordinance from 50 to 60 employees; NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
that the <u>Technical Requirements of The City of San Diego</u>
<u>Transportation Demand Management Ordinance</u>, adopted by resolution
on December 11, 1989, be amended as follows:

 Page 8, Paragraph IV.A. - Delete the subparagraph heading "1. Large Employers" and delete subparagraph IV.A.2., Intermediate Employers.

- 2. <u>Page 8, Paragraph IV.B.2.</u> Delete the words "in the same Employer category."
- 3. Page 9, Paragraph V.A.2. Delete the words "of 50 or more Employees" from the second sentence.
- 4. Page 10, Paragraph V.D.3. Delete the last sentence beginning with "The average EDAR shall be calculated"
- 5. Page 11, Paragraph V.E.4. Delete the last two sentences beginning with "The average EDAR shall be calculated "
- 6. Page 11, Paragraph V.E.5. In the table, delete Work Sites No. A, B, F, K, L and M, and renumber the remaining Employers and Work Sites accordingly.


 Replace the calculations below the table with the following:

Average EDAR =

(60 X 85%) + (150 X 80%) + (100 X 75%) + (500 X 75%) + (200 X 90%) + (100 X 85%) + (70 X 80%)/(60 + 150 + 100 + 500 + 200 + 100) = 85%

7. Page 27, Glossary - Replace the definition of Employer
with the following:

"Employer" shall mean a sole proprietor,
partnership, corporation, unincorporated
association, joint venture, or other business
entity that employs 60 or more Employees. This
definition relates to the total number of



Employees at each Work Site and not to the total number of Employees for all Work Sites.
