

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-282000

ADOPTED ON MAY 18, 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO ADOPTING A ONE YEAR MORATORIUM ON  
ANY NEW REGULATIONS WHICH MAY HAVE A NEGATIVE  
IMPACT ON BUSINESS.

WHEREAS, there are regulations which the Council of The City  
of San Diego has the discretion to implement; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that new regulations which  
are mandated or prescribed by State or Federal legislation can  
not be effected nor will be effected; and

WHEREAS, the Council, on March 15, 1993, directed the City  
Manager to place a twelve month moratorium on any new  
regulations, which it has the discretion to implement, that  
negatively affected businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego in an effort  
to enhance the economic development opportunities for the  
citizens of San Diego has implemented a strategy for regulatory  
relief; and


WHEREAS, a key element of this strategy will include a  
moratorium on any new regulations and changes to existing  
regulations which may have a negative impact on the ability of  
existing and new business to maintain or expand their activities  
in The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
that it is in the public interest that a moratorium be  
implemented on any new regulations and changes to existing

regulations which may have a negative effect on existing and new businesses within the City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing contained in this resolution is intended to limit the Council's ability to protect the public health, safety and welfare or otherwise limit the Council's police power authority.
