<u>SUMMARY</u>

<u>Issue</u> - Should the City Council approve the following recommended firms as members of the financing team for the proposed current refunding of \$3,990,000 City of San Diego Mortgage Revenue Bonds, 1983 Series A (University Canyon Apartments located at 2098 Via Las Cumbres):

<u>Financial Advisor</u> - Evensen Dodge Inc. (75%) and The Knight Group Inc. (MBE and WBE - 25%);

<u>Bond Underwriter</u> - Banc One Capital Corporation and E.J. De La Rosa & Co. (MBE - 20%);

Bond Counsel - Stradling, Yocca, Carlson & Rauth (80%) and Fatica, Boutwell and Behrend (WBE - 20%).

Recommendation - It is so recommended.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u> - The fees and expenses of the financing team are contingent upon the sale of the proposed refunding bonds and will be included in the cost of issuance. The compensation schedule is included as Attachment 1 to this report.

<u>MBE/WBE Impact</u> - All the proposals include participation by MBE/WBE firms in accordance with established City of San Diego Minority and Women Business Enterprise goals.

Previous Related Action(s) - The original issuance of bonds was authorized by the City Council on April 18, 1983 (Ordinance O-15946). On March 15, 1993, the Housing Commission approved the firms of Evensen Dodge and the Knight Group as financial advisor and on April 19, 1993, the Commission continued the selection of a bond underwriter for this bond refunding. On May 17, 1993, the Commission approved Banc One Capital Corporation and E.J. De La Rosa & Co. as the selected bond underwriters.

<u>Future Related Action(s)</u> - If the recommended action is approved, then the Housing Commission and the City Council will be requested to authorize the reissuance of bonds.

BACKGROUND

On April 19, 1993 the Housing Commission continued the selection of a bond underwriter for the University Canyon bond refunding and directed staff to form another selection committee to re-evaluate the selection of a recommended firm.


DISCUSSION

On April 27, 1993, a <u>new</u> selection committee met to re-evaluate the selection of a bond underwriter. The committee consisted of the representatives of the City Attorney's Office, City Auditor's Office, Centre City Development Corporation, the Neighborhood House, General Counsel, Evensen Dodge and The Knight Group, the Commission's financial advisor.

The committee recommended the selection of Banc One Capital Corporation and E.J. De La Rosa & Co. as bond underwriters for the refunding. The Housing Commission approved the recommended firms on May 17, 1993.

Pursuant to the policy for the selection of financing team members, each bond issue, bond refunding, or bond restructuring requires selection of a Financial Advisor, Bond Underwriter and Bond Counsel on a competitive RFP basis (Attachment 2). The final selection of the financing team members is made by the issuing body (City Council or Housing Authority).

Under the policy, it is the responsibility of the City Attorney's office to select a bond counsel using a competitive process. The City Attorney's selection of the bond counsel firm is based on the results of their RFP process.

CONCLUSION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the selection of the proposed members of the financing team for the proposed bond refunding. If approved, the financing team will start working with staff in preparing the necessary documentation for the contemplated refunding which will be submitted for consideration and authorization by the Housing Commission board and the City Council.


