RESOLUTION NUMBER R-282061 (R-93-1971)

ADOPTED ON JUN 01 1993

WHEREAS, Public Law 101-510, Title XXIX required the Secretary of Defense to submit a list of proposed military base closures and realignments to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission on March 15, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 281798 on April 26, expressing its support for NTC San Diego and San Diego's Shipyard industries; and

WHEREAS, the Commission, since its first round of public hearings, has added two more important San Diego Naval facilities to their list to be studied for closure; Naval Air Station Miramar and Naval Aviation Depot North Island; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has scheduled a second public hearing in San Diego on June 3, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the closure of NAS Miramar would result in the loss of a combined payroll of over \$286 million and would put over 2,000 civilian workers out of work; and

WHEREAS, the closure of NADEP North Island would result in the loss of \$389 million to the regional economy and put almost 5,000 people out of work; and

WHEREAS, the closure of NAS Miramar and NADEP North Island would also cause the closure of the Defense Distribution Depot, resulting in the loss of an additional 470 civilian jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Defense has designated San Diego as a "Mega Port" for the Navy because this region possesses all the critical elements to the success of the military mission and saves taxpayers money; and

WHEREAS, it is clear that San Diego must retain our training facilities, air station, aviation depot, and ship repair capabilities if we are to be an effective "Mega Port"; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby express its support for the retention of Naval Air Station Miramar and Naval Aviation Depot North Island, in addition to its previously stated support for NTC San Diego and San Diego's ship repair industries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of Legislative Services is directed to communicate with and provide a copy of this resolution to San Diego's congressional delegation and to the City's legislative advocates in Washington, D.C.
