ADOPTED ON JUN 28 1993

WHEREAS, Captain Frederic Douglas Glogower ("Captain Glogower") will be detaching from his present duties here in San Diego to become the Chairman of the Psychology Department in Bethesda, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, since arriving in San Diego sixteen years ago, Captain Glogower has been promoted to his present rank of Captain, including being "deep selected" to the rank of Commander ahead of his peers; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glogower served as the first Chairman of Psychology at the Naval Medical Center, San Diego, and in that capacity, orchestrated the creation of a separate and new department; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glogower has provided direction and oversight in the creation of a Navy psychology internship, which was so impressive and complete that it received the maximum number of credentialed years possible from the American Psychological Association during its first review; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glogower is nationally recognized for his work supporting the National Science Foundation's research efforts in the Antarctic, and has chaired a panel of researchers at a conference investigating the application of Antarctic research to the efforts of space exploration; NOW, THEREFORE,
